

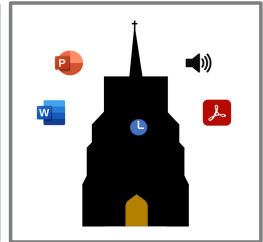
The St Leonard's Educational Resource:

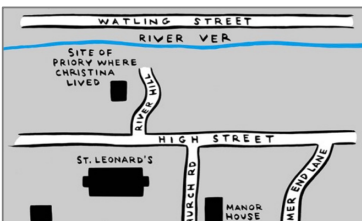

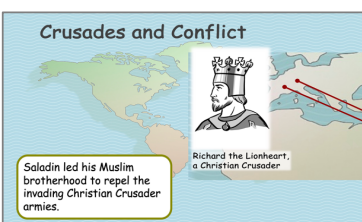
