







Exterior graffiti around South Porch arch [clockwise numbering]

<p>1</p>		<p>lower left</p> <p>Difficult to interpret. Appears to include initials, but close examination suggests the surrounding outline might represent the arch itself, and within (perhaps) a coffin passing through the arch??</p>
<p>2</p>		<p>upper left</p> <p>Initials "DH". Might a familial relationship be implied from the occurrence of the initials "EH" in the corresponding right-hand side location (5)?</p>
<p>3</p>		<p>top left</p> <p>A geometric inscription (though with what may be some initials close by, which might or might not be contemporaneous).</p>
<p>4</p>		<p>upper right</p> <p>Initials "WP" and a (reasonably) clear date: 1679</p>
<p>5</p>		<p>mid right</p> <p>Initials "EH"</p>
<p>6</p>		<p>lower right</p> <p>A more chaotic geometric inscription, possibly resulting from overlapping additions made at different times?</p> <p>NOTE: original photos reveal more detail than the printed images.</p>
